Nancy J. Truedson, age 87 years, formerly of Cypress, Illinois, passed away Thursday evening, August 17, 2017, at 5:20 PM at her residence at The Anchor at River to River Residential Community in Marion.

Nancy was born December 14, 1929 in Fairport, New York. She was the daughter of Clarence E. and Frances (Watley) Grabb.

On June 26, 1970, Nancy was united in marriage to Russell Dale Truedson in Aurora, Illinois. He preceded her in death on June 15, 2009.

She later spent many years teaching in the Batavia, Illinois School System and concluded her educational career in California.

Nancy was a member of the League of Women Voters when she resided in Batavia. Additionally, she had served on the Cypress, Illinois Village Board.

Nancy enjoyed attending auctions and flower gardening. She is fondly remembered for her love of children. Her legacy is her family and the lives and minds that she touched during her teaching career.
