Viola Alene Huckelberry, age 92 years, a resident, along with her sister, Imogene, of the Autumn Ridge Supportive Living Center in Vienna and a former resident of the Belknap community passed away Friday morning, March 27, 2026, at 7:28 A.M. at Hillview Senior Living and Rehabilitation in Vienna.

Alene, as she was known to family and friends, was born December 28, 1933 at the family home at Belknap. She was the daughter of John Franklin Felker and May Estella (Keys) Felker.

On November 8, 1952, Alene was united in marriage to Gene Huckelberry in Corinth, Mississippi. He preceded her in death on April 26, 2012.

Alene was a faithful Christian and was a member of the Belknap Pentecostal Church.
