Alice Louise Taylor, age 75 years, a resident of rural Ozark and a former resident of Marion and Sparta, passed away unexpectedly Monday afternoon, November 30, 2015, at 4:30 PM at her home.

Louise was born February 29, 1940 in Marion, Illinois. She was the third of four children born to Earl and Velma (Garner) Kelley.

On November 8, 1958, Louise was united in marriage to Charles Ray Taylor at Freedom Baptist Church in Marion. Together they enjoyed 57 years of marriage. He survives.
