



## Amy Lou Liesemeyer

Amy Lou Liesemeyer, age 91 years, a resident of Metropolis and a former resident of Tunnel Hill, passed away Wednesday morning, November 23, 2016, at 2:45 AM at the Metropolis Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Metropolis.

Amy was born May 21, 1925 in Tunnel Hill. She was the daughter of Gus Choate and Ada (Spencer) Choate.

On September 13, 1963, Amy was united in marriage to Reuben H. Liesemeyer in Herrin, Illinois. He preceded her in death on September 28, 2012.
