Arlen M. Campbell, son of George Campbell & Hattie (Lancaster) Campbell, was born November 21, 1911 in Kewanee, MO. He departed this life Wednesday morning, April 7, 2004 at 5:10 AM at Medco of Paducah, KY. At the time of his passing, Arlen had attained the age of 92 years 4 months & 16 days.

Arlen was united in marriage to Louise (Cruse) on August 18, 1931 in Benton, MO. She preceded him in death on June 28, 1982. Arlen was later united in marriage to Ruth (nee Sloan) Beggs on September 2, 1982 in Brookport, IL. She survives.
