Barbara S. (Treat) Davis, age 85 years, a resident of South Roxana, Illinois and a native of the Cypress community, passed away Thursday evening, May 15, 2025, at Alton Memorial Hospital.

Barbara was born on June 29, 1939 to Willard and Sarah (Mathis) Treat in Johnson County, Illinois.
