August 17, 1925 - July 7, 2022

Betty Lee (Price) Brown Gee, age 96 years, a resident of Vienna, passed away Thursday morning, July 7, 2022, at 2:45 AM at the Saline Care Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Harrisburg.

Betty was born August 17, 1925 in Columbus, Ohio. She was the daughter of Harry Quail Price and Carrie Nation (Quisenberry) Price.

Betty was united in marriage to Clem Leo Brown. He preceded her in death. She was later united in marriage to Richard Gee.

Survivors include: her grandchildren – James Brown of Harrisburg and Traci (Frank) Throgmorton of Vienna; 9 great grandchildren; and 10 great-great grandchildren.

In addition to her parents and husbands, Betty was preceded in death by: twin infant sons – Danny and Donnie Brown; a son – Clem Lee Brown; a grandson – Daniel “Danny” Brown; a granddaughter – Sheri Lauderdale; an infant great grandson – Hunter Lauderdale; a brother – Thomas Price and a sister – Maxine Smith.

During the second World War, Betty worked in military airplane manufacturing in Evansville, Indiana and she also worked in a naval shipyard. She was

proud of her service as a “Rosie the Riveter.” Following the war, Betty was employed as a waitress, seamstress and worked at the Harrisburg cap factory.

Betty was a member of the Richmond Hill, Georgia American Legion Ladies auxiliary. She was of the Baptist faith.

In her spare time, Betty enjoyed needlepoint, sewing and gardening. She particularly enjoyed taking care of small children and had babysat since her youth. She is fondly remembered for her love of hosting kid’s pool and pizza parties.

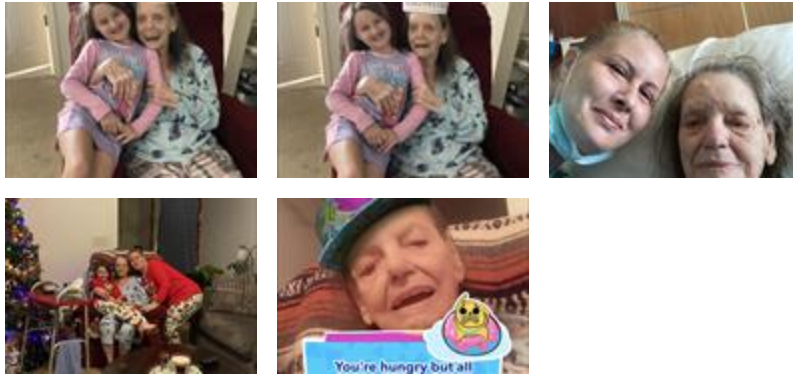
