Billy Gene Butler, Sr., age 70 years, a resident of Goreville and a former resident of the New Liberty community, passed away Monday afternoon, February 9, 2015, at 12:55 PM at his home.

Billy was born January 8, 1945 in Livingston County Kentucky. He was the son of Gilbert Eugene & Pearl (Skinner) Butler.
