Bob operated "Bob's Radio & TV Service" on the square in Vienna for 45 years retiring in 2001.

Bob surrendered his life to the Lord in 1963. He was a member of Tunnel Hill

Baptist Church until is closed in 1997. He then became a member of Gilead Cumberland Presbyterian Church near Simpson, IL until his death.

Bob was on active duty until May 1954 and received an Honorable Discharge in May of 1960 from the United States Marine Corps Reserves. He was a Corporal in charge of jet mechanics at the El Toro, CA facility during the Korean War.

Bob graduated from Southern Illinois University in August 1956 with an Associates Degree in Electronics Technology. He served in the Civil Defense through the Sheriff's Auxiliary in Johnson County.
