Catherine Taylor, daughter of Alden Deaton & Mary Elizabeth (Martin) Deaton, was born March 25, 1924 in Stonefort, IL. She departed this life Sunday evening, June 29, 2003 at 9:31 PM at the Massac Memorial Hospital in Metropolis, IL. At the time of her passing, Catherine had attained the age of 79 years 3 months 4 days.

Catherine was united in marriage to Lewis Taylor on December 24, 1949 at the United Methodist Church in New Burnside, IL. He preceded her in death on November 15, 1995.
