Charles L. Littleton, age 85 years, a resident of rural Cypress, passed away Monday morning, July 26, 2021, at 1:15 AM at his home, surrounded by members of his loving family.

Charlie, as he was affectionately known to family and friends, was born February 1, 1936 in Dongola, Illinois. He was the son of Charlie Shelvia Littleton and Ora Lela (Miller) Littleton.

On January 22, 1955, Charlie was united in marriage to Verla Marie Houseright in Karnak, Illinois. She preceded him in death on October 23, 1999. Charlie was later united in marriage to Kay F. Mayberry on October 22, 2004 at the Henry County Courthouse in Paris, Tennessee. She survives.
