Cindy A. Matheny-Evans, 65, a resident of Herrin, Illinois, passed away Saturday morning, October 18, 2014, at 5:30 AM at her home.

Cindy was born September 30, 1949 in Elizabethtown, Kentucky. She was the daughter of John & Anna (Kisak) Holmes.

On November 24, 1979, Cindy was united in marriage to Larry D. Matheny, Sr. at Orland Park, Illinois. He preceded her in death on November 28, 2007. She was later united in marriage to Herbert Evans on July 5, 2011 at Du Quoin, Illinois. He survives.
