Clinton Eugene Warren, age 82 years, a resident of rural Buncombe, Illinois, passed away Sunday afternoon, December 29, 2024, at 12:18 P.M. at SIH Memorial Hospital in Carbondale, Illinois.

Clinton was born June 4, 1942 in Thebes, Illinois. He was the son of Elige Warren and Lois Louise (Robertson) Warren.
