Dixie L. Deel, age 80 years, a former resident of the Reevesville community, passed away Sunday, March 15, 2026 at 5:59 A.M. at Providence Pointe Healthcare in Paducah, Kentucky.

Dixie was born on June 24, 1945 at the family home in Reevesville. She was the youngest of seven children born to Henry and Florence (Trout) Troutt.

On October 19, 1963, Dixie was united in marriage to David N. Deel. Together, they shared over 50 years of marriage.
