Doris Irene Lingle, age 84 years, a resident of rural Goreville, passed away Saturday morning, January 6th at 8:50 A.M. at SIH Herrin Hospital.

Doris was born October 13, 1939 in the Flatwoods Community of Johnson County to Howard and Myrtle (Gurley) Breeden.

On December 25, 1957, Doris was united in marriage to Bill C. Lingle at Glendale, Illinois. Together, they shared 55 years of marriage until his passing in 2012.

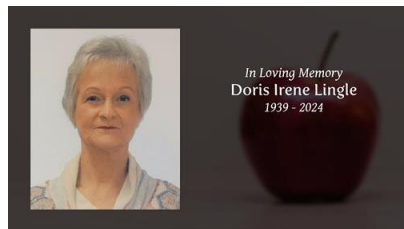

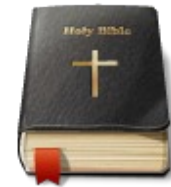
