Doris Jean Webb Phillips, age 75 years, a resident of Marion and formerly of Tunnel Hill, passed away Wednesday afternoon, February 19, 2020 at 2:14PM at Deaconess Gateway in Evansville, Indiana.

Doris "Jean" as she was affectionately known by her family and friends was born November 10, 1944 in Carbondale, Illinois. She was the daughter of Ray Webb and Golda (Hankla) Webb.
