Dorothy Elizabeth Carter, age 93 years, a former resident of rural Cypress, passed away Saturday morning, June 17, 2017, at 10:06 AM at Heartland Regional Medical Center in Marion.

Dorothy was born December 18, 1923 in Chicago, Illinois. She was the daughter of Anthony D. and Barbara (Neuefeind) Lucas.

Dorothy was united in marriage to Thomas E. Carter. He preceded her in death in August 1969.
