Dustan B. Hoffman, age 63 years, a resident of Vienna for the past 22 years and a former resident of Green Bay, Wisconsin, passed away Tuesday evening, May 14, 2019, at 7:31 PM at his home near Vienna.

Dustan was born July 3, 1955 in Green Bay, Wisconsin. He was the second of four children born to Donald and Elizabeth (Oskey) Hoffman.

Dustan was united in marriage to Ruth Manders. She preceded him in death on November 15, 1994. He was later united in marriage to Debra L. Fournier in Vienna on March 20, 2019.
