Edna L. Hall, age 95 years, a resident of rural Grantsburg, passed away Tuesday morning, February 2, 2016, at 12:50 AM at the Southgate Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Metropolis.

Edna was born August 24, 1920 near Eddyville, Illinois. She was the sixth of seven children born to Charlie and Teresia (Basinger) Brush.

On June 1, 1936, Edna was united in marriage to Hartley Hall at the Reevesville United Methodist Church parsonage. He preceded her in death on April 16, 1992.

Edna had been a faithful member of the Golden Circle Senior Citizens Center in Golconda. She was also a member since the late 1940s of the Dixon Springs Baptist Church where she served for many years as the song leader and also taught in the children's Sunday School department.

Edna is remembered for her love of raising flowers. She was also a skilled seamstress and provided custom sewing service, as well as quilt making. Edna also enjoyed making handcrafted crochet items. She had made afghans for each of her family members as well as quilts for many of her relatives and friends.
