



Ethel Fay Bloodworth

February 16, 1935 - August 28, 2024

Ethel Fay Bloodworth, age 89 years, a resident of rural New Burnside, passed away Wednesday, August 28, 2024, at 6:39 P.M. at Deaconess Gateway Hospital in Newburgh, Indiana.

Ethel was born February 16, 1935 in the White Ash (formerly Dog Walk) community in Williamson County Illinois. She was the daughter of Ernest and Mary (LaBott) Jack.

In February 1955, Ethel was united in marriage to Philip J. "P.J." Bloodworth. He preceded her in death on May 8, 2009.
