Etta C. Dunn, age 90 years, a resident of rural Vienna, passed away Tuesday morning, October 29, 2019, at 1:50 AM at the Metropolis Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

Etta was born March 21, 1929 in Massac County Illinois. She was the daughter of Claude and Inez (Harris) Chapman.

On May 28, 1947, Etta was united in marriage to Ray W. Dunn in Vienna, Illinois. He preceded her in death on January 3, 1994.

Etta is survived by: her son – Robert W. (Barbara) Dunn of Vienna; a granddaughter – Stephanie (Tom) Kest of Virginia; great grandchildren – Madison, Jacob, Cheyenne, Isabella, and Thomas; great-great grandchildren – Roxanne, Silas and Jeffery; as well as a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
