Frances M. "Fran" Stewart, age 84 years, a resident of Vienna and a former resident of Buncombe, passed away Wednesday evening, May 7, 2014, at 11:25 PM at the Westside Rehabilitation and Care Center in West Frankfort, Illinois.

Fran was born February 20, 1930 in Buncombe. She was the daughter of Daniel Madison McCall and Gussie Emma (Cox) McCall.

Fran was united in marriage to W. Dale Stewart on June 1, 1946 in Vienna. He preceded her in death on May 21, 1998.

Fran is survived by a cousin- Mary Ellen Arvai; as well as a dear and special friend, whom she loved as a daughter, Belinda Halvorsen and her family. Fran also leaves her extended family and many dear friends to cherish her memory.

In addition to her parents and husband, Fran was preceded in death by a foster son, Gene Hatton.

Fran attended the Buncombe Public School and Vienna High School. She was employed as a production supervisor by DuKane Corporation in St. Charles, Illinois for approximately 20 years, prior to her retirement on June 1, 1984.

In 1987, Fran and her husband Dale, made property available for the development of the current Vienna City Park. Fran enjoyed sewing, making handcrafts, and watching and taking care of animals. She especially enjoyed watching butterflies, birds and squirrels in her yard. Fran was a member of the Vienna Church of Christ. Fran was honored in February by being selected as the "Valentine Queen" at the Westside Care Center. Fran had a great love for people and always greeted everyone with a warm and friendly smile.

A graveside memorial service will be conducted Sunday afternoon, May 18, 2014, at 2:30 PM at the Vienna Fraternal Cemetery. Brother Bill Brandstatter and Brother Ben Wiles will officiate. Those attending the service are asked to gather at the cemetery at approximately 2:15 Sunday afternoon.
