James “Frank” Throgmorton, age 55 years, a resident of Vienna, Illinois, passed away unexpectedly Monday, August 26, 2024 in Franklin County, Illinois.

Frank was born March 18, 1969 in Marion, Illinois. He was the son of James Joseph Throgmorton and Polly Anne (Whitener) Throgmorton.

On July 25, 1992, Frank was united in marriage to Traci Brown at the Land Street Church of God in Harrisburg, Illinois. She survives.

Frank is also survived by: his sons – Jimmy Joe Throgmorton and Scot Throgmorton both of Vienna, Illinois; a sister – Sally Van Rheeden of Chestnut, Illinois; nephews – Max, Sam, Brian, and Daniel.

In addition to his parents, Frank was preceded in death by an infant nephew – Hunter.

Frank was a 1987 graduate of Vienna High School. For many years, Frank was employed in the golf course design and construction industry. He was involved in the construction phase of the Gambit Golf Course in Vienna. He later served as the superintendent of the Union County Golf Course at Anna and then returned to the Gambit Golf Course in Vienna as superintendent.

Frank's work in golf course construction took him throughout much of the United States, as well as foreign countries, including China, Egypt and Hong Kong. More recently, Frank worked as an equipment operator for the Sugar Camp Coal Mine near Benton, Illinois.

Frank was honored as a Kentucky Colonel. He was an avid deer hunter. Frank also enjoyed collecting movies and caps.

Frank was a member of the First Christian Church in Vienna.

Funeral services will be held Sunday afternoon, September 1, 2024, at 2 P.M. at Bailey Funeral Home in Vienna. Pastor Harold Miller will officiate.

Burial will be in the Vienna Fraternal Cemetery.
