August 14, 1918 - October 8, 2005

George C. Cletis Turner, son of George Garfield Turner and Gertie (Dunn) Turner, was born August 14, 1918 in Cypress, Illinois. He departed this life Saturday afternoon, October 8, 2005, at 12:07 PM at the Union County Hospital in Anna, Illinois. At the time of his passing, Cletis had attained the age of 87 years 1 month & 24 days.
