Helen S. Kubian, age 88, a resident of rural Vienna, passed away Tuesday morning, May 24, 2016, at 9:06 AM at her home.

Helen was born December 13, 1927 in her family's home in Perth Amboy, New Jersey. She was the daughter of Stephen and Elizabeth (Solar) Sisolak.

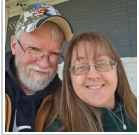
