Hunter was preceded in death by: her maternal grandfather – Richard Goetz and paternal grandfather – Byron Lowrey.

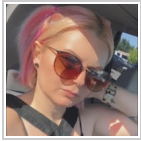
Hunter was a 2014 graduate of Harrisburg (Illinois) Township High School. She was employed as an assistant manager at the Goreville Dollar General Store.
