James C. Moak, age 66 years, a resident of Vienna and a former resident of Cypress, passed away Saturday morning, September 20, 2014, at 2:39 AM at his home.

Jim was born February 5, 1948 in Anna, Illinois. He was the son of Eldon A. & Ruth E. (Crowell) Moak.

On December 1, 1972, Jim was united in marriage to Charmion D. Humphrey at Mound City, Illinois. She survives.

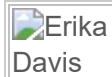
