Joe C. Perry, age 80 years, a resident of Vienna, Illinois, passed away Monday morning, October 12, 2015, at 1:22 AM at the Herrin Hospital.

Joe was born September 8, 1935 in Winfield, Alabama. He was the son of Clyde Stone Perry and Susie Louise (Smith) Perry.

Joe was united in marriage to Phyllis A. Hill. She preceded him in death on November 18, 2013.

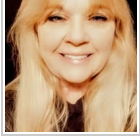

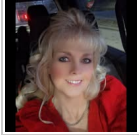
