Joseph Earl Dungan, Jr., age 80 years, a resident of East Alton, Illinois and a former resident of Vienna, passed away Monday morning, August 14, 2023, at 4:50 A.M. at Robings Manor in Brighton, Illinois.

Joseph was born May 26, 1943 in Carbondale, Illinois. He was the son of Joseph Earl Dungan, Sr. and Nadine (Whiteside) Dungan.

Joseph was formerly united in marriage to Margaret Rose Brown.
