Kenneth Riley Trigg, age 82, a resident of rural Simpson, Illinois and a former resident of Washington, Illinois, passed away Sunday morning, November 6, 2016, at 11:25 AM at his home.

Kenneth was born February 17, 1934 in Peoria, Illinois. He was the son of Burt and Ida Trigg.

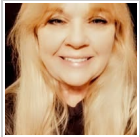
