Leatrice Pearl, 86 years, resident of Carbondale, Illinois and former resident of Rantoul, Illinois from 1968 – 1997, passed away Monday November 11, 2013 at 1:28 AM at Hillview Health Care Center in Vienna, Illinois. Lee was born April 19, 1927 in Boston, Massachusetts. She was the daughter of Morris and Elizabeth (Weiner) Camiel.
