



## Linda L. (Dillow) Alsip Rudolph

Linda L. (Dillow) Alsip Rudolph, age 78 years, a resident of Dongola and a former resident of Vienna, passed away Sunday morning, September 20, 2015, at 12:25 AM at the Union County Hospital in Anna.

Linda was born December 8, 1936 in Dongola. She was the daughter of Glen Paul Dillow and Opal (Goodman) Dillow.

On July 31, 1955, Linda was united in marriage to Harold Alsip in Greenville, Mississippi. He preceded her in death on September 24, 1976. Linda was later united in marriage to Wesley Vernon Rudolph. He preceded her in death on December 12, 1987.

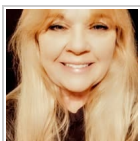
