Lindell Dewayne Johnson, age 65 years, a resident of Harrisburg, Illinois, passed away Monday afternoon, September 2, 2024, at 5:45 P.M. at his home.

Lindell was born November 2, 1958 at the Hardin County General Hospital in Rosiclare, Illinois. He was the son of Dee A. and Wanda M. (Shoemaker) Johnson.

On May 12, 1989, Lindell was united in marriage to Vickie Lynn Ewan at the Simpson Baptist Church. She survives.

During his employment at V.C.C., Lindell was a member of the A.F.S.C.M.E. (American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees) Local # 415. He had served as chief steward as well as president of the local. He was also an active participant of the Harrisburg chapter of the A.F.S.C.M.E. retirees.

Lindell enjoyed farming, raising cattle and horseback riding. In his younger years, he was an avid hunter.

Lindell was of the Baptist faith.
