December 10, 1934 - April 30, 2022

Louella Parks, age 87 years, a resident of the Reevesville community, passed away Saturday evening, April 30, 2022, at 8:42 PM at the Hillview Health Care Center in Vienna.

Louella was born December 10, 1934 in Johnson County Illinois. She was the daughter of William Henry Troutt and Naoma Florence (nee) Troutt.

On July 28, 1951, Louella was united in marriage to Fred Parks. He preceded her in death on December 9, 1999.
