Lowell L. Chapman, Jr., age 69 years, a resident of rural Vienna, passed away Monday morning, January 5, 2026, at 9:50 A. M. at the Ray and Kay Eckstein Hospice Care Center in Paducah, Kentucky.

Lowell was born August 21, 1956 in Metropolis, Illinois. He was the son of Lowell L. and Clara L. (Weddington) Chapman.

On November 28, 1980, Lowell was united in marriage to Tena Lingle at the former Forman Pentecostal Church. She survives.

In addition to his wife, Lowell is survived by: his daughter – Keisha R. (Dustin) Joyner and their son Spencer all of Paducah, Kentucky. Lowell was an avid outdoorsman and in his youth, he had enjoyed hunting. Lowell is remembered for his love of work. He was generous almost to a fault and would give anyone in need his last dollar or the shirt off of his back. He loved to make people laugh.

During his illness, Lowell fought a hard fight but he fought it well.
