Margaret Alice Rule Curl, age 96 years, a resident of Vienna and former resident of Manteno, Illinois from 1938-2006, passed away Friday morning, December 1, 2017, at 7:45 AM at Hillview Health Care Center in Vienna.

Margaret was born April 13, 1921 near Noble (Richland County) Illinois. She was the daughter of William and Amanda (VanMatre) Rule.
