Marjorie Bellamy, daughter of Charles Merritt Howell & Brooksie (Dunn) Howell, was born August 14, 1909 near Vienna, IL. She departed this life Tuesday evening, March 2, 2004, at the Southgate Health Care Center in Metropolis, IL. At the time of her passing, Marjorie had attained the age of 94 years 6 months & 17 days.

Marjorie was united in marriage to Guy Bellamy on November 23, 1930 in Golconda, IL. He preceded her in death on January 25, 1999.

Chapter # 30 Order of the Eastern Star and was a member of the former Valley # 108 White Shrine of Jerusalem. Marjorie was an active sponsor of the Rainbow Girls organization. She was a charter member of the Fellowship Baptist Church. Marjorie enjoyed sewing & quilting.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon, March 5, 2004, at 2 PM at the Fellowship Baptist Church in Vienna. Interment will be in the Vienna Fraternal Cemetery.
