Mary M. Stewart, age 92 years, a resident of rural Buncombe, Illinois, passed away Sunday afternoon, November 16, 2014, at 12:25 PM at Hillview Health Care Center in Vienna.

Mary was born May 28, 1922 near Mattoon, Illinois. She was the daughter of Alva & Gladys (Humble) Cain.

Mary was united in marriage to Clyde Stewart and he preceded her in death in 1973.

Survivors include: her son – Mike Stewart of Buncombe; a granddaughter – Stephanie Stewart of Mayfield, Kentucky; a foster grandson - Cody Rainbolt of Vienna; a brother – Gerald Cain of Anna; and a host of nieces and nephews.

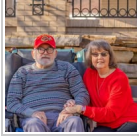
