December 30, 1916 - March 26, 2010

Mary Throgmorton, a life long resident of Johnson County, passed away Friday morning, March 26, 2010, at 3:20 AM at the Rosewood Care Center in Elgin, Illinois at the age of 93. Mary was born on December 30, 1916 in Ballowe community, IL to Harmon and Lois (Ridenhower) Alford. She was the last surviving member of the 10 Alford siblings: Oscar, William, Joseph, Harry, Neil, Carrie Alford Davis, Robert, Daisy Alford Davis, and Henry. Mary married Herald Throgmorton on September 27, 1936 in Metropolis. He preceded her in death after 62 years of marriage. She was an active homemaker who enjoyed sewing, cooking, and her family.
