Michael Dale Hines, 38, was a resident of Cape Girardeau, Missouri for the past 20 years and a former resident of the New Columbia community in Massac County Illinois. Mike passed away Saturday afternoon, June 27, 2015, at 12:18 PM at Southeast Missouri Medical Center in Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

Mike was born September 23, 1976 in Bloomington, Illinois. He was the son of Gary D. and Debbie L. (Castleman) Hines. They reside in the New Columbia community.

In addition to his parents, Mike is survived by a brother – Jared Duane Hines of the New Columbia community and a sister – Stacie Lynn (Zachary) Allen of Hermitage, Tennessee; a niece – Taylor Paige Hines; and a host of other relatives and many dear friends.
