Michael McRoy, also affectionately known as Mike or Mikey, passed away on December 22, 2025, at 10:46 a.m. at his home. He was born in Kentucky on March 30, 1947, to Mary Louise (Rowan) Jones. Michael lived at Mulberry Manor and Holly Hill in Anna before moving in 1992 to Glen Brook of Vienna, where he resided for many years and became a familiar and valued member of the community.

Michael graduated June 20, 1977, from John A Logan Collage with his Basic education. Mike worked at the MAP Training Center and previously at Johnson County Developmental Training Center in Vienna. He also worked at This N That flower shop in Vienna, IL for many years, a role well suited to his kind and giving nature. Michael was deeply caring toward others and truly never knew a stranger—he greeted everyone with warmth, conversation, and genuine interest. He found joy in fishing, watching WWE, listening to country music, and going to church. Michael was a faithful member of Fellowship Baptist Church of Vienna, where his faith and fellowship was an important part of his life. He was Baptized June 17th, 1990, at Trinity Church in Anna.

He especially loved participating in the Special Olympics, competing in snowshoeing, basketball, and softball throw. He took great pride in his accomplishments and would often say, with a smile, "I have 200 gold medals." Michael is survived by his brother, Robb Dillinger (Lisa), and his sister, Cindy Shumate, Nieces and Nephews, Bridget Privett & Billy Snyder along with Rob and Ryan Dillinger, all residing in Florida, along with his Glen Brook family, friends, church family, and all who were blessed to know him.

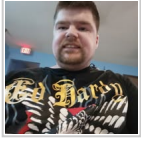

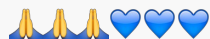
