



## Murl Hutson

April 10, 1936 - April 29, 2018

Murl Dean Hutson, age 82 years, a resident of rural Stonefort, passed away Sunday, April 29, 2018, at 2:54 PM at her home.

Murl was born April 10, 1936 in Union County, Illinois. She was the second of four children born to William Ward Niblock and Gladys (Kelley) Niblock.

Murl was united in marriage to Billy Ray Hutson on November 26, 1955 in the Dykersburg community. He survives.

Murl was a graduate of Dongola High School. She received training and certification as a certified nurse's aide (C.N.A.) at St. Joseph's Hospital in Joliet. Later, she received recertification through John A. Logan Community College. Murl worked as a C.N.A. at the former Creal Springs Nursing Home as well as providing private home duty nursing care service.

Murl was the eldest female member of the Indian Camp Missionary Baptist Church. She enjoyed mowing, gardening and caring for her flowers. She particularly enjoyed raising tulips.

A service honoring the life of Murl Dean Hutson will be conducted Thursday afternoon, May 3, 2018, at 1 PM at Bailey Funeral Home in Vienna. Murl's son, Rev. Mark Hutson, will officiate. Burial will be in the Cypress Cemetery.
