Myrtle Lula Glover, daughter of John Alford Dunkin & Mary Bucca (Mason) Dunkin, was born July 7, 1911 in Bloomfield, Missouri. She departed this life Monday morning, May 24, 2004, at 10:55 AM at the Hillview Health Care Center in Vienna, IL. At the time of her passing, Myrtle had attained the age of 92 years 10 months & 17 days.

Myrtle was united in marriage to Cecil Glover on September 6, 1930 in Dexter, MO. He preceded her in death in 1986.
