Myrtle I. Breeden Mizell, daughter of Rolla Anson Gurley & Margaret Edith (Ward) Gurley, was born September 24, 1910 east of Cobden, Illinois in the Water Valley region of Union County. She departed this life Friday morning, March 25, 2005, at 2:30 AM at the Hilltop House in Creal Springs, Illinois. At the time of her passing, Myrtle had attained the age of 94 years 6 months & 1 day.
