Patricia Anne “Trish” (Penrod) McNichols, age 79 years, a resident of rural Vienna, passed away peacefully Saturday afternoon, May 2, 2020, at her home. She was surrounded by members of her beloved family. Trish, as she was affectionately known, was born June 24, 1940 in Harrisburg, Illinois.

On August 23, 1959, Trish was united in marriage to Martin “Wardell” McNichols at Metropolis, Illinois. Together, Trish and Wardell enjoyed 60 years, 8 months and 10 days of marriage.

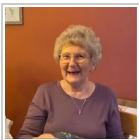
