



## Paula "Jean" Street

May 15, 1955 - May 2, 2018

Paula "Jean" Street, age 62 years, a resident of rural Vienna, passed away Wednesday morning, May 2, 2018, at 9:40 AM at Memorial Hospital in Carbondale.

Jean, as she was affectionately known, was born May 15, 1955 in McLeansboro, Illinois. She was the daughter of Pola E. and Ruth Laverne (Thomas) Smith.

On August 15, 1975, Jean was united in marriage to Roy Allen Street at the Second Baptist Church in Marion by Pastor George Smith.

In addition to her husband, Jean is survived by: their daughters – Tara Alisha (Andrew) Ehrhardt and Kara Alissa Carden all of Carbondale; a granddaughter – Sophia Michelle Carden; a nephew – Chris Norton; nieces – Diana Schmidt, Crystal (Curtis) Myers and Faith Ann (Cyrus) Elterman; great nephews – Daunte, Treveon, DeAndre, and CamRon Boens; as well as a host of cousins, other relatives and many friends.

She had also worked through Smart Company Temporary Services at Lourdes Hospital also in Paducah.

Jean was a former member of Egyptian Chapter # 30 Order of the Eastern Star and the Johnson County Homemaker's Extension. She is remembered for her love of making handcrafted crochet items, particularly pot-holders which she gave to family and friends. Jean and Roy were members of the Simpson Baptist Church.

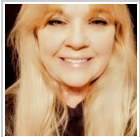
