Herman Ray Webb, age 81 years, a lifelong resident of the Ozark community in Johnson County Illinois, passed away Friday afternoon, March 8, 2024, at 5:12 P.M. at his home.

Ray, as he was known to family and friends, was born June 30, 1942 at the family farm near Ozark. He was the son of Herman and Edna (Trigg) Webb.

Ray is survived by: his twin sister – Faye Jewell of Washington, Michigan; 2 sisters – Alice Schneider of Denver, Colorado and Dorothy Simmons of Ozark, Illinois; 33 nieces and nephews; as well as a host of neighbors and friends, including his best friends – Gary Simmons, Dan Edmonds, and Harry Lee Treat.

In addition to his parents, Ray was preceded in death by: 7 brothers – Harold, Earl, Jim, Cecil, Frank, Fred 'Cotton' and Charles Webb; and 4 sisters –

Martha Webb, Myrtle Darga, Rosa Rheume and Mary Overdorff.

Ray attended the Reagan Public School. He was an avid outdoorsman. He enjoyed farming, horses, gardening, and raising blackberries. In recent years, he also enjoyed traveling extensively with his sisters.

Ray was a member of the Ozark Pentecostal Church.
