Robert G. "Bob" Marshall, age 66 years, a resident of rural Cobden, Illinois and a native of Metropolis, passed away Saturday morning, March 25, 2023, at 9:30 AM at his home.

Robert was born January 31, 1957 in Metropolis. He was the youngest of three children born to Herbert Edward Marshall and Lois Jean (Nolte) Marshall.

On September 5, 1998, Robert was united in marriage to Nancy Ellen (Lamer) Craig at First Baptist Church in Metropolis. She survives.

Robert was also survived by: a stepson - Brian (April) Craig of Shiloh, Illinois; two step-grandchildren - Noah Craig and Will Garcia Boyd; two sisters – Janet Mittendorf of Paducah, Kentucky and Carol (Alan) Racey of Vienna, Illinois; an aunt - Dorothy (Jim) Bailey of Godfrey, Illinois; as well as nieces, nephews and a host of many dear friends.

In his free time, he enjoyed gardening, canning, and building projects around his home. He was an avid outdoorsman and enjoyed hunting and fishing. Robert was an avid sports fan. He particularly enjoyed watching football and baseball. Robert operated “Marshall Calls” crafting and constructing duck and goose calls, He was also an accomplished pool player and had participated in pool league play through the years. Bob created a signature brand of barbecue sauce “Bob’s BBQ Sauce.”

Robert was a member of the Metropolis First Baptist Church.

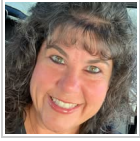

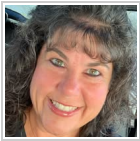
