



Ron Noble

August 18, 1946 - October 31, 2021

Ron Noble, age 75 years, a resident of Vienna, Illinois and a winter Texan, seasonally residing in Mission, Texas, passed away Sunday afternoon, October 31, 2021, at 2:23 PM at SIH Memorial Hospital in Carbondale.

Ron was born August 18, 1946 in Carbondale, Illinois. He was the son of T.A. and Betty (Cox) Noble.

Ron is survived by: his mother – Betty Noble of Vienna; his children – Ron (his wife, Hope) Noble, Jr. of Mission, Texas, James B. Noble of San Antonio, Texas, Yvonne R. (her husband, John) McAteer of San Antonio, Texas, and Laura A. (her husband, Robert) Noble-Nelson of New Braunfels, Texas; 7 grandchildren; 3 great grandchildren; as well as a host of other relatives and many friends.

Ron was preceded in death by his father, T.A. Noble, and a brother – Terry Noble.

Ron was a 1964 graduate of Vienna High School and San Antonio Community College. He enlisted in June 1964 in the U.S. Air Force and served in the Vietnam War. Ron was honorably discharged in 1968. He was a Life Member of the Beggs-Gurley VFW Post # 5222 in Vienna as well as the American Legion.

Ron's working career was in retail shoe sales. Following his retirement, he became a casino host in the Diamond Lounge at Harrah's Casino in Metropolis.

Ron was a member of the N.R.A. (National Rifle Association). He was an avid outdoorsman. Ron enjoyed fishing, hunting, playing shuffleboard, shooting pool and throwing darts.

Ron was a member of the Christian faith.

Military graveside rites will be accorded at 11 AM Saturday, November 6, 2021, at the Vienna Fraternal Cemetery.

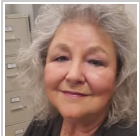
