Rose Lillian Morris, age 80 years, a resident of rural Simpson, Illinois and a former resident of Pacific, Missouri, passed away Monday morning, July 3, 2023, at 3:10 A.M. at the Southgate Health Care Center in Metropolis.

Rose was born September 18, 1942 in St. Louis, Missouri. She was the eldest child born to Charles and Dorothy (Yokel) Fine.

On July 20, 1984, Rose was united in marriage to Phil R. Morris in St. Charles, Missouri. He survives.
